## **SCOREKEEPER'S DUTIES**

#### Home Team

- Track scoring in the "Official Scorebook" provided by North City.
- The official scorebook can be picked up from the snack bar prior to the first game. If multiple games on the day, usually the scorekeeper of the following game may well be at the field, if so you can make the transition. Please return to the snack bar after final game of the day.
- The official scorekeeper shall sit near the umpire. The official scorekeeper may not be in the dugout or on the field.
- Complete the lineups for home and away teams; name and number.
- The official scorekeeper shall record at-bats, hits, runs, errors, strikeouts, baseon-balls, innings pitched and the pitch count. This shall be recorded for the away and home teams.
- The Official Scorekeeper shall notify the umpire or manager of the following: 1) Batter is batting out of order. 2) Pitcher is close to his/her pitch-count limit.
- Official start time should be noted in the scorebook. As well as the date.
- At the end of game, have the umpire sign the official scorebook.
- Immediately after the conclusion of your game please email Chief Scorekeeper Bill Lacey at <a href="mailto:ncyb-scores@googlegroups.com">ncyb-scores@googlegroups.com</a> or text 858-245-0673 with the final score. Please also provide the name and team of any player hitting over-the-fence HR's.
- It is your responsibility to find a replacement if you are not able to keep the official scorebook during a game

 You will need to keep score using the electronic scoreboard. The remote to control the scoreboard can be found at the following Mt. Etna field locations: <u>Bronco:</u> Snack Bar; <u>Mustang:</u> Mustang shed; <u>Pinto:</u> Pinto shed.
